On March 22, 2019, as amended on April 2, 2019, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed a Dynamic Transfer Balancing Authority Operating Agreement (Agreement) between CAISO and Gridforce Energy Management, LLC (Gridforce). CAISO states that the Agreement provides the terms and conditions for dynamic schedule and pseudo-tie arrangements between the CAISO and Gridforce balancing authority areas. Waiver of the Commission's notice requirements pursuant to section 35.11 of the Commission's rules and regulations (18 C.F.R. § 35.11) is granted, and your submittal is accepted for filing, effective April 12, 2019 as requested.¹

Your filings were noticed on March 22, 2019 and April 3, 2019, with comments and interventions due on or before April 12, 2019. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed document(s); nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed

contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.
