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Take notice that on December 29, 2000, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (ISO) tendered a proposed amendment (Amendment No. 35) to the ISO Tariff. The modifications proposed in Amendment No. 35 include the following: changes related to distributed Generation, including changes that will clarify the metering and telemetry requirements for distribution-level Generation and changes that will reduce the threshold for participation by Generating Units in the ISO's Ancillary Services markets from 10 MW to 1 MW; modifications that will enhance the ISO's RMR pre-dispatch provisions; the incorporation into the ISO Tariff of requirements for Generators set forth in the Western Systems Coordinating Council Reliability Criteria Agreement; the addition of a mechanism to recover FERC Annual Charges from entities receiving transmission service on the ISO Controlled Grid; extension of the partial waiver of "No Pay" penalties for Participating Loads; a change to the deadline for submission of meter data to the ISO, which will align the Tariff with current practice; and several miscellaneous Tariff revisions necessary to comply with prior Commission orders and to correct typographical errors.

The ISO states that this filing has been served upon the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California, the California Energy Commission, the California Electricity Oversight Board, the owners of RMR Units, and all parties with effective Scheduling Coordinator Service Agreements under the ISO Tariff.

Any person desiring to be heard to protest said filing should file a motion to intervene or protest with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, 888 First Street, N.E., Washington, D.C. 20426, in accordance with Rules 211 or 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. §§ 385.211, 385.214). All such motions or protests must be filed in accordance with § 35.9 of the Commission's regulations. Protests filed with the Commission will be considered by it in determining the appropriate action to be taken but will not serve to make the protestants parties to the proceeding.
