

1 Purpose

The purpose of this document is to capture and record a description of what the Users and Business Stakeholders of the project wish to obtain by providing high-level business requirements. This document establishes the basis for the agreement between the initiators and implementers of the project. The information in this document serves as input to determining the scope of projects and to all Business Process Modeling and System Requirements Specifications efforts.

Business requirements are what must be delivered to provide value for the Users and Business Stakeholders. Systems, software, and processes are the ways (how) to delivery, satisfy or meet the business requirements (what). The Initial BRS will provide sufficient information to determine the scope of the project and will provide the functional business requirements so that the Architecture Decision can be made. Following the Architecture Decision, the remaining non-functional business requirements, such as data, performance, web services, and security can be added to complete the Final BRS.

The purpose of this project is to implement Settlements performance improvements to statement generation processes by Fall 2018 Release. The additional market data created as the ISO extends EIM opportunities and new resources to surrounding Balancing Authorities (BA) throughout the West, has caused performance issues in the existing Settlements systems.

The existing file structure is a risk. There is a risk in the creation and posting of the actual bill determinant file. To mitigate the risk, we will break up the bill determinant contents broken into smaller file sizes.

This project means to address the performance improvements required to successfully support current stakeholders and additional EIM entities.

The scope of the Settlements Performance Improvements include:

- a. Performance improvements for Post Bill Determinant Mapping process
 - i. Non-production storage issue causing delays to the statement publication
- b. Performance improvements of Statement Generation (BD File Size issue):
 - i. Daily Statements generation
 - ii. Monthly Statements and Invoice generation
- c. Changes related to the XML file split
- d. Ccode removal



SPI- BRQ002	Settlement informational file interface (SIFI) shall generate the common bill determinant file per BAA. For example, there will be one common BD file for the CAISO BAA and a separate common BD file for each EIM BAA entity.	Core	Settlements


