On October 21, 2020, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed to comply with the Commission's order issued on September 21, 2020.¹ CAISO states that the revisions clarify tariff section 30.12.4.3 regarding the settlement of recoverable amounts. The revisions are in satisfactory compliance with the September 21 Order, and are accepted for filing, effective on CAISO's actual implementation date,² consistent with the September 21 Order.³

The filing was noticed on October 21, 2020, with protests or interventions due on or before November 12, 2020. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.
