Reference: Operating Agreements and Notices of Termination

Dear Mr. Anders:

On December 6, 2013, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted three concurrent filings related to agreements between CAISO and the Western Area Power Administration- Desert Southwest Region (Western). In Docket No. ER14-551-000, CAISO filed a notice of termination of an interconnected balancing authority area operating agreement (IBAAOA) between itself and Western. In Docket No. ER14-568-000, CAISO filed an adjacent balancing authority operating agreement (ABAOA) to replace the terminated IBAAOA. In Docket No. ER14-569-000, CAISO filed a dynamic transfer operating agreement (Dynamic Transfer Agreement) between itself and Western that provides for continued dynamic transfers after the IBAAOA terminates. The notice of termination of the IBAAOA, the new ABAOA and the new Dynamic Transfer Agreement are accepted for filing, effective February 5, 2014, as requested.

The filings were noticed on December 9, 2013, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before December 27, 2013. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and

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Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification or any rule, regulation or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your tariff; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

This action is taken pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
