**Re: EQR Submittal Q2, 2009 – Request for Extension of Time to Submit  
Docket No. ER02-2001-000**

Dear Secretary Bose:

The California Independent System Operator Corporation (“ISO”) respectfully requests a thirty (30) day extension of time to file the 2009 Quarter 2 Electric Quarterly Report (EQR) submittal with the Commission. The requested extension would provide the ISO until August 30, 2009 to file the submittal of the required EQR.

Our request for an extension is necessary due to a software issue that the ISO identified to the Commission’s EQR support staff (FERC Online Support) several days ago that has prevented the ISO’s submittal of its already-completed EQR. On July 30 the ISO was informed by a FERC Online Support representative that the issue is not one that can be resolved by FERC Online Support and that the EQR software developer that is expected to be able to resolve the issue is out of the office until after the Quarter 2 EQR submittal date of July 31, 2009. It is our hope that the requested 30 day extension will be adequate time for FERC Online Support and the software developer to resolve the issue. The ISO stands ready to submit its EQR as soon as the software issue is resolved.
