Reference: Large Generator Interconnection Agreement

Dear Mr. Weaver:

On April 29, 2016, California System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted for filing a non-conforming large generator interconnection agreement (LGIA) among itself; San Diego Gas and Electric Company; and Mesquite Solar 3, LLC, SEP II, LLC, and SGS Development, LLC as interconnection customer co-tenants (collectively, Mesquite Solar). CAISO states that the LGIA provides for the interconnection of a solar photovoltaic generating facility located in Maricopa, Arizona. CAISO states that the facility will utilize an existing interconnection comprised of two 500 kV generation tie lines between the Hassayampa Switchyard and the Mesquite 230/500 kV Switchyard. CAISO's submittal is accepted for filing, effective June 1, 2016, as requested.

The filing was noticed on April 29, 2016, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before May 20, 2016. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in

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the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

This action is taken pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – West under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
