On April 25, 2016, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted revisions to section 24.5.2 (Project Sponsor Application and Information Requirements) and Appendix X (Approved Project Sponsor Agreement) of its tariff to comply with the Commission's March 25, 2016 Order. the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
