On June 21, 2002, you submitted for filing an Attachment, in compliance filing with a Commission order issued on May 22, 2002,¹ that required the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) to make publicly available the process by which Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E) allocates Available Transmission Capacity (ATC) among existing rights holders and how this process relates to the CAISO's calculation of ATC over Path 15. Your submittal is accepted as being in satisfactory compliance with the Commission's May 22 Order. Rate schedule designations are provided on the Enclosure.

This filing was noticed on July 10, 2002, with protests, comments, or motions to intervene due on or before July 22, 2002. No protests or comments were received. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any unopposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification or any rule, regulation or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation

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associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against the California Independent System Operator Corporation.

This action is taken pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Tariffs and Market Development - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
