## <u>Topic 1 – Affected Systems</u>

The Modesto Irrigation District ("MID") thanks the CAISO for the opportunity to comment regarding the CAISO's draft Tariff language for Topics 1 and 2 in its Interconnection Process Enhancements 2015 stakeholder process. MID has reviewed the reorganized draft Tariff language regarding Topic 1 as to Affected Systems and is able to state that it does not oppose the CAISO's draft Tariff language for Topic 1 on Affected Systems. MID underscores its support for the CAISO's continued inclusion of the following Tariff language, which MID believes is essential to the protection of Affected Systems' legal rights: "An Affected System's mitigation remedies that may be available outside the CAISO Tariff are unaffected by these provisions." In addition, MID notes that there is a missing word in the Tariff language in the second to last paragraph of Section 3.7.1, sixth line: the word "are" should be inserted in between the words "legitimate reliability issues" and "present". Again, MID thanks the CAISO for its continued efforts in this stakeholder process.
