Reference: Distribution of Forfeited Funds

Dear Mr. DiCapo:

On December 11, 2012, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted a petition seeking Commission approval to distribute to Scheduling Coordinators, in accordance with the relevant provisions of Appendix Y to the CAISO tariff, \$6,317,986.44 in forfeited funds from interconnection customers that withdrew from the interconnection queue during calendar year 2011. CAISO states that, as of June 30, 2012, the forfeited funds had accrued \$7,192.21 in interest, and that once it receives Commission approval to distribute the forfeited funds, the final interest amount will be recalculated to correspond to the actual day on which the distribution will occur. CAISO also requests confidential treatment of Attachment 1 to its filing, in accordance with 18 C.F.R. § 388.112. CAISO's submittal is accepted for filing.

This filing was noticed on December 12, 2012, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before January 2, 2013. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in

the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
