CALIFORNIA INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPERATOR CORPORATION MOTION TO ADJUST THE TRACK 2 SCHEDULE FOR LOCAL CAPACITY TECHNICAL ANALYSIS AND FLEXIBLE CAPACITY NEEDS ASSESSMENT FOR 2021

Pursuant to Rule 11.1 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) moves that the Commission modify the Track 2 schedule for filing the CAISO's Flexible Capacity Needs Assessment (*i.e.*, the flexible capacity requirements or FCR) and Local Capacity Technical Analysis (*i.e.*, the Local Capacity Requirements or LCR). Due to factors outside of the CAISO's control, the CAISO will not be able to provide the draft LCR by April 1, 2020 nor the final FCR by May 1, 2020. As a result, the CAISO recommends that the Commission modify the procedural schedule accordingly.
