On January 8, 2021, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed revisions to its Open Access Transmission Tariff to clarify specific market rules and definitions related to co-located resources. Specifically, CAISO's revisions permit co-located resources to deviate from dispatch instructions under very specific conditions; and, clarify the definitions for Mixed-Fuel Resources and Hybrid Resources.¹ The revisions are accepted for filing, effective March 12, 2021, as requested.

This filing was noticed on January 8, 2021, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before January 29, 2021. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made
