<u>Transmission Revenue Credit</u> The proceeds received by the Participating TO from the

ISO for Wheeling service and Usage Charges, plus the

shortfall or surplus resulting from any cost differences

between Transmission Losses and Ancillary Service

requirements associated with Existing Rights or Non-

Converted Rights and the ISO's rules and protocols.

TRBA (Transmission Revenue Balancing Account)

A mechanism to be established by each Participating TO that has transmission customers that will ensure (a) that all

Transmission Revenue Credits flow through to its

transmission customers, and (b) that the costs of each

applicable non-wires project assessed to a Participating

TO under Section 3.7 of the ISO's Tariff are recovered

from the transmission customers of the applicable

Participating TO.

TRR (Transmission Revenue Requirement)

The TRR is the total annual authorized revenues associated with transmission facilities turned over to the Operational Control of the ISO by a Participating TO that

has transmission customers, and for which FERC

jurisdictional entities are permitted to include in their

Access Charges for recovery from customers, or in the

case of non-FERC jurisdiction entities, the equivalent
