Meeting Minutes Review and Updates

• The Next Market Planning and Performance Forum (MPPF) meeting is scheduled of April 18, 2019.

Weekly Market Performance Report

For March 20- April 2, 2019, in the day-ahead market there was some over-supply during the mid-day hours driven by solar output and low loads. There was also local congestion caused by seasonal outages. The reasons for the real-time market price spikes are listed in the report.

Questions on the Updates or Weekly Market Performance Report

Q: During the sunlight hours and low load days, we observe curtailment of solar resources. Why is this energy not exported to other areas?

A: During low load periods, the ISO does export energy to other balancing areas. This export energy is either scheduled as hourly exports or EIM transfers. The ISO presented a chart during the MPP which shows that the ISO is net exporter in some hours.

Q: In the Market performance report for March 6 through 19, the maximum and minimum Pnode LMPs were around \$31,000 and minimum around -\$42,427. Are these prices correct?

A: These high prices were posted on OASIS due to an internal processing issue. This issue was rectified and these prices have been corrected.

Q: On April 3, 2019, in the day-ahead market the 30275_CRESTA _230_30330_RIO OSO _230_BR_1 _1 constraint was binding with shadow price above \$1000. What conditions were driving these high prices ? **A:** The congestion on this line was driven by an outage and bids.

Review of the Price Correction Report

During the week of March 25-29, 2019, the ISO processed 18 price corrections due to software defects. During the week of April 1-5, 2019, the ISO processed 106 price corrections due to a software defect and a data input error.
