Update to Transmission Maintenance Procedure No. 1:

Chris Hillman, California ISO Senior Advisor - Transmission Assets reviewed the new section added to Transmission Maintenance Procedure No.1 regarding annual reporting requirements. The new section incorporated membership input on the procedure gather at the April 21, 2022 TMCC meeting and outlined measures to help PTOs meet the required timelines and established a formal escalation procedure in the event they don't. The revisions to Transmission Maintenance Procedure No.1 were unanimously approved and the ISO committed to posting the revised procedure on the ISO website.

Open discussion items:

Justin Flores (PG&E) asked if the membership had any additional information on the transformer explosion at Hoover Dam. The transformer was owned and maintained by the Bureau of Reclamation but no additional information surrounding the cause was known.
