

Counsel began the process of preparing the required copies with what counsel anticipated to be more than sufficient time. Nonetheless, a number of the photocopying machines at counsel's office were out of order or otherwise malfunctioned. When it became apparent that a paper filing would not be possible, the ISO attempted to file the Rebuttal Testimony and Exhibits electronically. The Commission's electronic filing system, however, "timed out" several times instead of accepting the filing, and counsel was not able to effect the filing by the 5:00 p.m. deadline.

When it became clear that the filing would not be accomplished, the ISO contacted the Presiding Judge and participants via e-mail to indicate that the filing would be made today.


