The CAISO is an active participant in many Commission proceedings, including the Commission's Resource Adequacy and Integrated Resource Planning proceedings.

In this proceeding, the Commission seeks party feedback on the Coalition for Community Solar Access (CCSA) proposed Net Value Benefit Tariff (NVBT) and other topics related to the consideration of a community renewable energy program. The Commission's *Ruling Setting Aside Submission of the Record to Seek Comments on Aspects of Net Value Benefit Tariff Proposal*, issued on November 6, 2023, seeks additional party feedback on the NVBT proposal regarding grid reliability and capacity values, guardrails, and interconnection.
