Details: The following changes will be effective as of Wednesday, May 17, 2023:

The California ISO is implementing an enhancement to the Resource Interconnection Management System (RIMS) application as part of the Interconnection Process Enhancements (IPE) Initiative to improve the Generator Interconnection and Deliverability Allocation Procedures (GIDAP). IPE Phase 1 benefits Market Participants by improving the generator interconnection process, providing greater visibility and transparency to stakeholders, eliminating manual workarounds, and providing a single source of data.





What's changing?

As part of the Interconnection Process Enhancements (IPE) Initiative Phase 1, there are two new updates to the *Project Info* sub tab under the *App & Study* navigation menu in RIMS.

 There is a new box for 'Gen-tie' sharing in the Resource Summary tab. This field can only be edited by admins or power users.

In RIMS, go to *App & Study > Project Info >* Select a project and click on the green **View** button > *Resource Summary* tab








 There are new file types for gen-tie sharing agreements when the Document Type = OTHER. This field can only be edited by admins or power users.

In RIMS, go to *App & Study > Project Info >* Select a project and click on the green **View** button > *Documents* tab > Upload Project Files

When the **Select a Document Type** = OTHER, the existing list will include new file types:

- Gen-tie Sharing Agmt
- MMA
- LOS
- Repower
- Post-COD Mod
- Other

Note: MMA (Material Modification Assessment), LOS (Limited Operation Study)
