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Public Utility District No. 1 of Snohomish County, Washington, (“Snohomish”) submits these comments in response to CAISO’s Straw Proposal on the reliability coordinator rate design, terms and conditions. Snohomish is registered as a Transmission Operator and is located inside the balancing area (“BA”) of the Bonneville Power Administration (“BPA”).

Snohomish generally agrees with the comments BPA is concurrently submitting to CAISO. In addition, we submit these comments:

Comment: Services Agreement. Snohomish is unclear as to CAISO’s reasons for electing to submit the Reliability Coordinator Service Agreement to FERC. CAISO should explain this election versus not submitting the agreement to FERC.

Comment: Billing. Snohomish supports CAISO’s ability to directly invoice TOPs located within a BA area that are RC Customers. Snohomish currently pays for RC services directly and would prefer to continue to do so.
