#### Comments:

SunEdison generally supports the CAISO's proposal for this topic with some qualifications. These qualifications are addressed in the LSA's stakeholder comments. The need for flexibility in determining final project size (post Interconnection Request) is extremely important. The annual downsizing policy would allow SunEdison the ability to reduce project size due to evolving factors in project development stages. From potential PPA demands, environmental restrictions, site design, and permitting, the downsizing opportunity would allow SunEdison to correctly size projects when warranted.

SunEdison generally supports the CAISO's proposal for this topic with some qualifications. These qualifications are addressed in the LSA's stakeholder comments. Although, the CAISO's proposal for Topic 1 should generally address any issues under this Topic 2 proposals. SunEdison and other developers can use the annual downsizing opportunity to cancel project phases or portions if there are any constructability issues. Nevertheless, the CAISO should allow developers to cancel project phases if the Interconnection Customer pays the cost of associated Network Upgrades needed by later queued projects.
