## Here are our two comments:

- 1) There are Cluster 7 projects that were submitted without energy storage options. What is the process to add energy storage to these sites via Material Modification Assessment Request?
- 2) Will the non-energy storage Cluster 7 projects be studied in combination with the energy storage projects or will energy storage projects be handled in a separate study? Considering the amount of energy storage applied in Cluster 7, combining energy storage with the non-energy storage projects in the same study could cause undue complications and delays to the non-energy storage project studies while the CAISO develops the energy storage study process.
