Enclosed please find an original and fourteen copies of a Notice to Market of Ability to File Disputes on Final Settlement Statements ("Notice") issued on December 3, 1999 by the California Independent System Operator Corporation ("ISO") pursuant to Amendment No. 22 to the California Independent System Operator Corporation FERC Electric Tariff ("ISO Tariff").

The ISO filed Amendment No. 22 to the ISO Tariff in the above-captioned docket on September 27, 1999. Amendment No. 22 consisted of a number of proposed modifications to the ISO Tariff, including Tariff revisions which would establish a procedure for Scheduling Coordinators to dispute new or modified charges or credits that appear for the first time on a Final Settlement Statement ("Incremental Changes"). The ISO requested that these Tariff revisions be made effective on the later of November 26, 1999 or at least ten days after the ISO posted notice on the ISO Home Page that the modified software necessary to implement these revisions was ready for use.

The Commission accepted the Tariff revisions and proposed effective dates in Amendment No. 22, subject to certain conditions, by order issued on November 24, 1999. *California Independent System Operator Corporation*, 89 FERC ¶ 61,229 (1999).

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The enclosed Notice states that, effective with Final Settlement Statements published on December 15, 1999 for Trade Date October 1, 1999, the ISO will accept settlement disputes of Incremental Changes that occur between Preliminary and Final Settlement Statements, pursuant to the terms of Amendment No. 22.

The ISO states that the enclosed Notice was e-mailed to Market Participants on December 3, 1999 and posted on the ISO Home Page, www.caiso.com, to satisfy the notice requirements of Amendment No. 22. The ISO further states that it has served the Notice upon each person designated on the official service list for the above-captioned docket, as indicated in the attached certificate of service.
