



Briefing on Results of RMR Contract Extensions for 2011

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General Session

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Management has determined to:

- Extend the RMR contract term for 2011 for:
 - Oakland Units 1, 2, and 3 (165 MW)
 - Potrero Units 3, 4, 5, and 6 (362 MW)

- Release the following resources from RMR status:
 - South Bay Units 1, 2 and CT (307)
 - Gilroy Units 1 and 2 (90 MW)
 - Feather River (45 MW)
 - Yuba City (45 MW)

Key RMR issues since September Board Meeting

- RMR status of Potrero
 - RMR contract extended
 - ISO will seek early termination once the two identified upgrades are completed and proven operationally reliable:
 - Martin-Bayshore-Potrero Recabling Project
 - Trans Bay Cable Project
- RMR status of South Bay
 - RMR contract extension withdrawn based on updated information on San Diego load forecasts
 - Updated forecasts received from CEC staff
 - September 27, 2010 – All time record SDG&E peak demand = 4,684 MW
