On August 15, 2008, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted an informational filing that provides notice regarding the CAISO's revised Transmission Access Charges effective June 1, 2008. The CAISO states that the basis for the revision is to implement the "out-of-cycle" Transmission Revenue Balancing Account adjustment of San Diego Gas & Electric Company, which was accepted in an unpublished letter order issued on April 28, 2008, in Docket No. ER08-759-000. Receipt of the CAISO's instant Informational Filing is acknowledged.

This filing was noticed on August 21, 2008, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before September 5, 2008. No protests or comments were filed.
