Dear Secretary Boergers:

Yesterday, I submitted for filing six copies of tariff sheets for the California Independent System Operator Corporation (“ISO”) FERC Electric Tariff, Original Volumes I and III, reflecting Amendments No. 10 and 11 to the ISO Tariff, and versions of those tariff sheets identifying the changes effected by those amendments. I also enclosed amendments to the ISO Tariff requiring the ISO to notify Scheduling Coordinators and owners and operators of sources providing Ancillary Services of any failure of such source to pass an availability test. These amendments were in compliance with the Commission’s October 16, 1998, Order.

It has come to my attention that the “black-lined” versions of the latter amendments were omitted from the documents filed with the Commission, although they were included in the service copies. I am enclosing the omitted pages.
