INTERNET ACCESS TO CALIFORNIA ISO BOARD OF GOVERNORS MEETINGS NOW AVAILABLE

(Folsom, CA) Starting with this week's meeting, audio broadcast of Board of Governor's meetings at the California Independent System Operator (California ISO) will be made available over the Internet. Interested parties can listen to meeting proceedings via streaming media that is accessed through a link provided on the California ISO web site (www.caiso.com/pubinfo/BOG).

Committee meetings scheduled for Wednesday, November 29th and the actual Board of Governor's meeting scheduled for Thursday, November 30th will be the first meetings to be broadcast using this new technology. System requirements to receive streaming audio are:

1. A sound card and speakers
2. PC with a minimum P-11 300 with 64 RAM
3. Multi media player software (available for download on the California ISO site)
4. An ISP connection (28.8K, 56K, 100K, T1 or LAN)

In addition to the access link, the California ISO web site also provides a FAQ document regarding the process, a test link, and agendas for the meetings. For the next several months, access to the Board of Governors meetings will be available via both the Internet and a toll-free telephone line.
