# MOTION OF THE CALIFORNIA INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPERATOR CORPORATION TO WITHDRAW ETARIFF FILING

#### I. Introduction

Pursuant to Rule 212 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R § 385.212) and the rules for filing rate schedules and tariffs under the Federal Power Act, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (ISO) submits this motion to withdraw its eTariff submittal of the baseline Service Agreement No. 785, Non-Conforming Meter Service Agreement for Scheduling Coordinators between the ISO and Western Area Power Administration – Desert Southwest Region submitted on June 8, 2011 in Docket ER11-3758-000. After recent consultations with Commission staff, it has been determined that this eTariff baseline submittal was not necessary and may be withdrawn. Accordingly, the ISO hereby withdraws the eTariff submittal filling and requests that the Commission take no action on the June 8 filling in this docket.
