Dear Mr. Ivancovich,

On February 16, 2012, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted for filing a revised tariff record to its open access transmission tariff in compliance with an order issued on February 1, 2012 in this docket.¹ Specifically, the revisions remove the limitation that the approved tariff revisions will apply only to projects eligible for cost recovery under CAISO's high voltage transmission access charge. CAISO has satisfactorily complied with the requirements in the order. Therefore, the revised tariff record is accepted, effective December 2, 2011.

Notice of filing was issued on February 17, 2012, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before March 8, 2012. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or

service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
