# ***Scope***

- ISO tariff requires an independent review of the ISO's code of conduct compliance
- Scope of procedures generally consisted of:
  - Obtaining listing of each constituent group:
    - Employees
    - Substantially full-time contractors
    - Board of Governors
  - Comparing listing to certifications, training requirement completion, and conflict of interest disclosure forms and follow up procedures, as applicable

---

## ***Results***

- Procedures are completed and the report was issued on January 31, 2013
- All planned procedures were performed without exception
- Report describes limited independent testing and findings related to the ISO's internal processes regarding the code of conduct requirements for the constituent groups listed on the previous slide
- High level of commitment and cooperation of ISO staff in completing this engagement, which is greatly appreciated
