#### Settlements Impacts of Day-Ahead Market Enhancements and Extension – Agenda Topics for 8/20/25

- Identify charge codes introduced or modified by DAME, EDAM, and ISO BAA Participation.

#### WEIM Settlements Overview

- WEIM/RTM Settlement
- RTM GHG attribution settlement
  - 491 Imbalance Settlement of supply resources who receive a real time GHG Obligation Award for GHG Region(s)
  - 495 Applies to each GHG Region and allocated to Metered Demand of GHG Region
- RTM Energy Transfer Revenue
  - 8470 Imbalance Settlement of TSR source/ sink for Transfer Revenue
    - RTM transfer revenue allocation
      - Direct allocation to transmission customer (TC) for released transmission (Type 2)
    - Otherwise, transfer revenue is shared between the source and sink BAAs (default is 50:50)
      - EDAM/WEIM BAA allocates transfer revenue according to its OATT
      - CISO transfer revenue allocation
        - » Pay TOR/ETC financial hedge across the transfer to financial SC
        - » Remaining transfer revenue pro-rata to measured demand minus TOR/ETC demand

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
