Application Software Changes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Transition to web-based user interface to eliminate the need to install thick client.</li><li>• Transition ADS provisioning to the Access and Identity Management (AIM) application including Resource Level Access Controls (RACL) access</li><li>• Display 15 minute schedules, 5 &amp; 15-minute Flex Ramp awards (FRU/FRD) in ADS GUI and will be available via B2B. Details will be communicated in BRS.</li><li>• Various enhancements (mostly related to user interface) adding content per Operation's request.</li></ul>
