Dear Secretary Reese:

The California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) hereby submits for filing a Certificate of Concurrence with respect to the unexecuted Large Generator Interconnection Agreement among RTSW Solar Park IV LLC (RTSW), Southern California Edison Company (SCE), and the CAISO (the LGIA).¹

I. Overview and Designated Filer

On October 28, 2025, SCE submitted the LGIA in Docket No. ER26-283-000, with a requested effective date of October 29, 2025. In that filing, SCE explained that the LGIA contained disputed issues, which the Commission resolved on March 27, 2026, via order, effective October 29, 2025.²

Rather than filing a duplicate version of the LGIA under the CAISO tariff, the CAISO is submitting a concurrence tariff record. The concurrence tariff record is designated under the CASO tariff as Service Agreement No. 9146.

SCE serves as the “designated filer” to the LGIA pursuant to the Joint Tariff Filing procedures outlined in Order No. 714.³ SCE filed the service agreement under SCE’s Open Access Transmission Tariff (“OATT”) and designated it as Service Agreement No. 343.

II. Proposed Effective Date and General Request for Waivers

Consistent with prior Certificates of Concurrence, the CAISO respectfully requests any waivers of the Commission’s filing regulations necessary to establish an effective date of October 29, 2025, for its Certificate of Concurrence for the LGIA. This will give the certificate an effective date consistent with the October 29, 2025 effective date that SCE requested in its October 28, 2025 filing. To the extent that the enclosed materials and information do not meet the detailed filing requirements of the Commission’s regulations, the CAISO respectfully requests that the Commission grant any necessary waivers.
