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# Goals for the policy catalog and roadmap

- Meaningfully engage external stakeholders
  - Stakeholders propose and advocate for their own initiatives
  - Final catalog includes stakeholder prioritization
- Transparent
  - Clear methods to identify and prioritize proposals
  - Open and transparent access to all stakeholders to influence policy enhancements roadmap
- Allows stakeholder prioritization to be considered in the ISO's internal planning processes, together with:
  - Alignment with ISO strategic goals and already planned work
  - Project impact on market efficiency and system reliability
  - Implementation cost
  - Other ISO commitments
- Incorporate urgent requests

# Expedited initiative on EDAM congestion revenue allocation

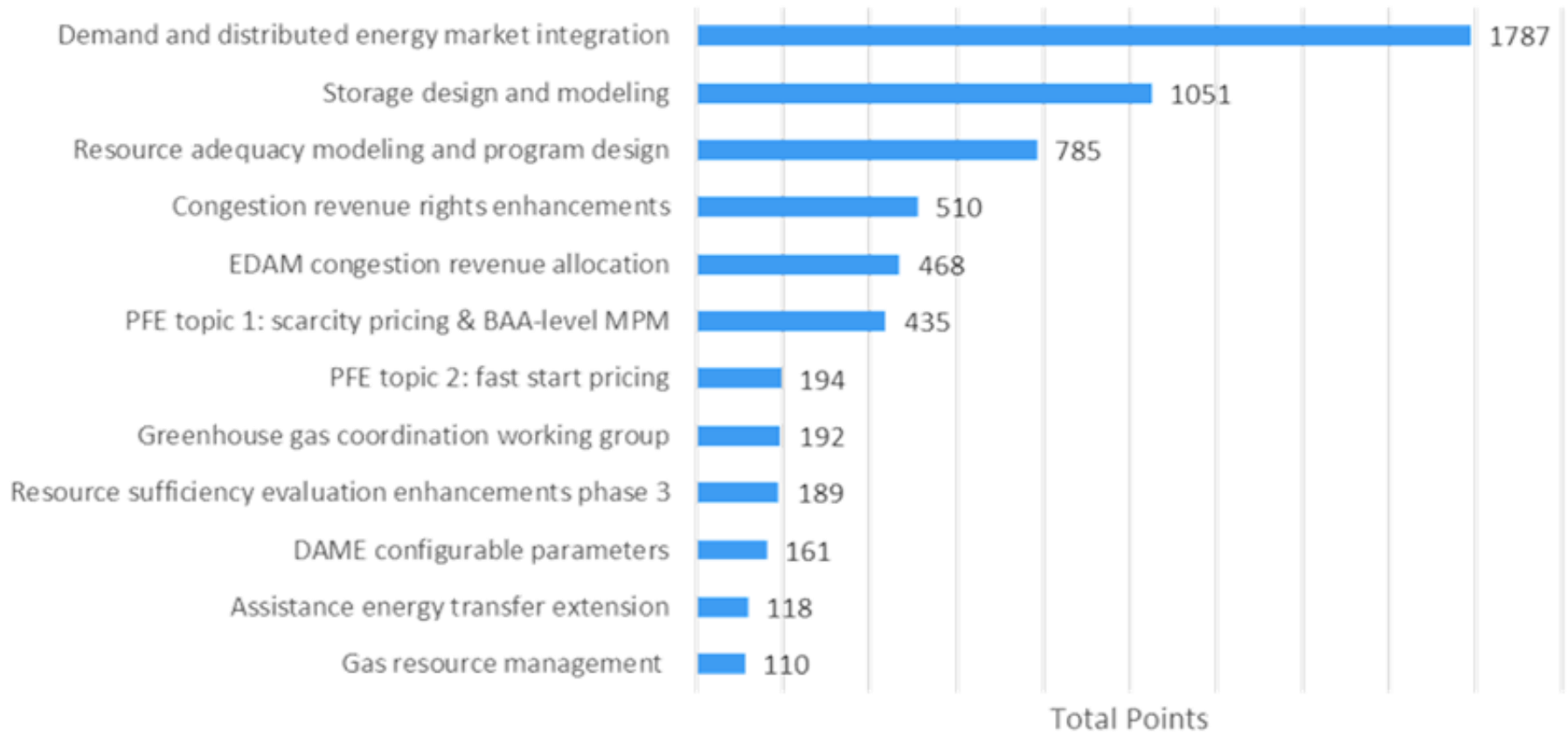
- Prompted the ISO to recalibrate the 2025 policy roadmap
  - Shifted the schedules of existing initiatives to accommodate new initiative workload
- ISO updated 2025 policy roadmap based on stakeholder-identified priorities
  - Stakeholder prioritization survey
    - Stakeholders prioritized both existing initiatives & new initiatives proposed via catalog submissions
    - Stakeholders asked to allocate a budget of 100 points across existing initiatives to indicate priorities
  - Regional Issues Forum (RIF) report

# Revised 2025 roadmap is a new step in the process

January	• 2025 kickoff stakeholder meeting
February	• Stakeholders submit policy initiatives to Catalog
April	• Stakeholder prioritization workshops + RIF roundtable
April	• Stakeholders submit prioritization rankings
 May	• Publish updated 2025 Policy Initiatives Roadmap + present at governance meetings
June	• Publish 2025 policy initiatives catalog
July	• Begin 2026-2028 policy initiatives roadmap development
November	• Draft policy roadmap released
December	• Final policy roadmap released

## 2025 Stakeholder Prioritization Survey Results: Current Policy Initiatives

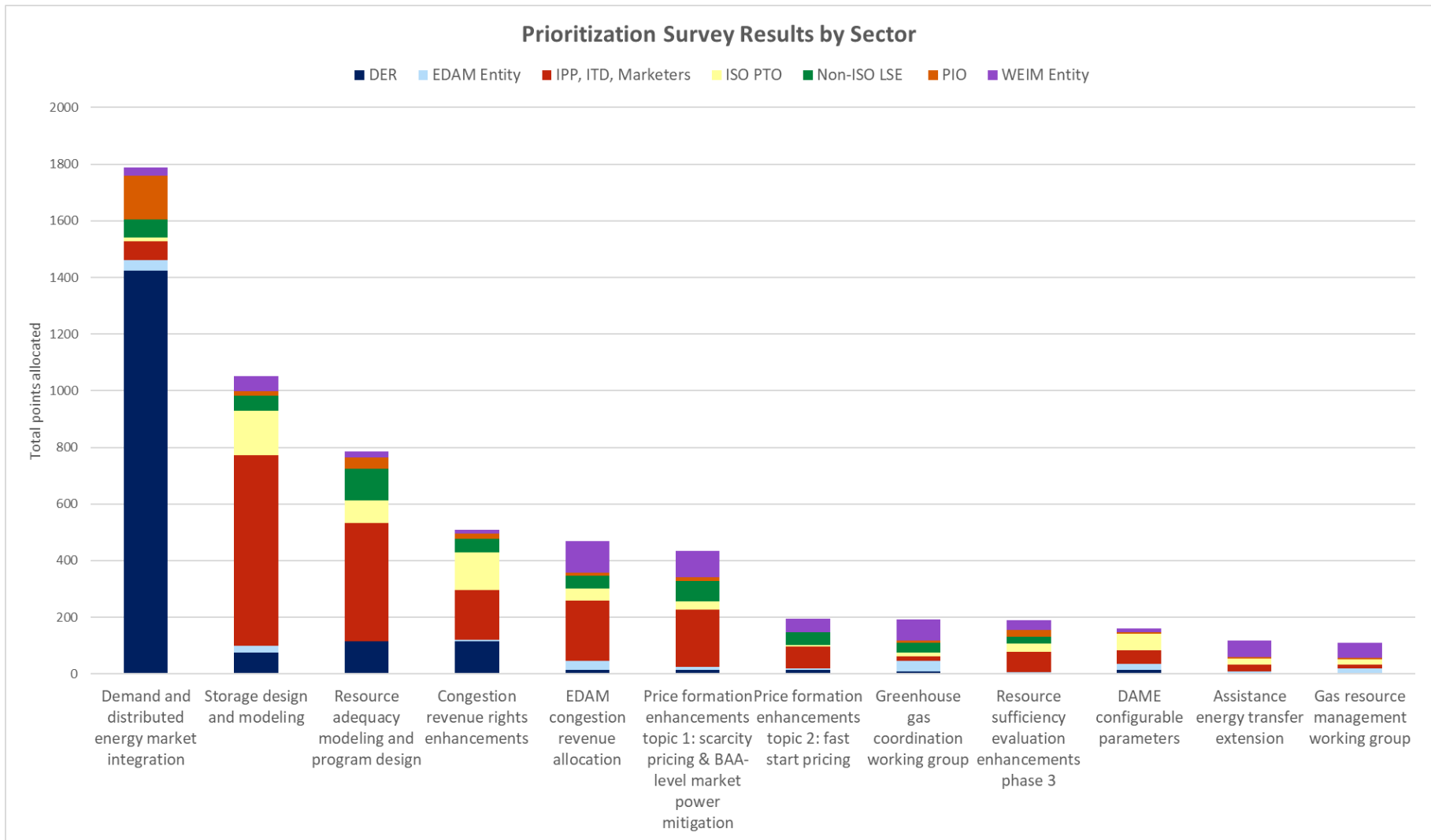

# Summary of roadmap changes

## Major changes

- Added EDAM congestion revenue allocation initiative
- Split WEIM assistance energy transfer extension from resources sufficiency evaluation phase 3
- Postponed resource sufficiency evaluation phase 3
- Postponed fast start pricing
- Postponed track 2 of demand and distributed energy market integration

## Minor changes

- Congestion revenue rights working groups extended additional quarter
- Greenhouse gas topic 3 concluded and topic 1 postponed to 2026 or later
- Greenhouse gas topic 2 decision moved from Q2 to Q4
- Resource adequacy track 1 decision postponed from Q3 to Q4
- Resource adequacy track 2 and 3b decisions postponed to 2026

  - Will be used as input to 2026-2028 policy roadmap development

  - Will include all postponed items from revised 2025 roadmap
