**CALIFORNIA ISO ASKS FERC TO REVOKE MARKET BASED RATE
AUTHORITY FOR FOUR GENERATING COMPANIES**

(Folsom, CA) The California Independent System Operator (California ISO) is hosting a media teleconference this afternoon at **2:00 p.m. Pacific Standard Time, Friday, June 8.** The topic is the California ISO's filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) regarding revocation of market based rate authority for Duke, Mirant, Dynegy and Reliant corporations, owners and operators of generating stations in California.

Charlie Robinson, California ISO Chief Counsel will discuss the main contents of the filing and will also be available to answer questions. The filings deal with different generating stations, but the language is nearly identical in each of them.
