**CAISO Stakeholder Process to Modify Tariff Definition of Regulatory Must-Take Generation**

The California Cogeneration Council (CCC) requests that the California Independent System Operator (CAISO) amend the stakeholder process addressing the proposed modification of the definition of Regulatory Must Take Generation, by extending the deadline for public comment from February 10<sup>th</sup> to at least February 24<sup>th</sup> (2 week extension). The remainder of the schedule will then need to be adjusted, such that the Final Proposal would be considered at either the April or May CAISO Board of Governors meeting.

On January 26, 2011, the CAISO posted a Revised Straw Proposal, and on February 2<sup>nd</sup>, convened a stakeholder conference call. On February 9<sup>th</sup>, representatives of the investor-owned utilities (IOUs) and the qualifying facility (QF) associations discussed via conference call, working together to propose modifications to the definition, that the parties could jointly support.

The CCC supports the collaborative endeavors of this working group, and respectfully requests that the stakeholders be given sufficient time to work out a comprehensive proposal that the members of these organizations can support.
