Dear Mr. Anders:

On November 14, 2014, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed a Notice of Termination of an Intra-Hour Scheduling Pilot Agreement (Pilot Agreement) with Bonneville Power Administration (Bonneville). CAISO states that intra-hour scheduling was terminated under the Pilot Agreement, concurrent with Bonneville's implementation of 15-minute scheduling on October 21, 2014 to comply with the requirements of Order No. 764. Your submittal is accepted for filing, effective October 21, 2014.

The filing was noticed on November 14, 2014, with comments, protests or motions to intervene due on or before December 5, 2014. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made

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by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against California Independent System Operator Corporation.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
