Dear Mr. Weinstein:

On October 31, 2007, as amended on November 1, 2007, you submitted for filing, on behalf of Los Medanos Energy Center, LLC (Los Medanos), proposed rate schedule sheets to a Must-Run Service Agreement (RMR Agreement) between Los Medanos and the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO).¹ The RMR Agreement sets forth the rates, terms, and conditions under which Los Medanos will provide reliability services to CAISO from the Los Medanos Energy Center for Contract Year 2008. The revised rate schedule sheets are accepted for filing effective January 1, 2008, as requested.

Notice of this filing was issued on November 5, 2007, with protests, comments, or motions to intervene due on or before November 21, 2007. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This acceptance shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have

been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now or pending or hereafter instituted by or against Los Medanos Energy Center, LLC.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Tariffs and Market Development -West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
