Selection process for WEM Governing Body members

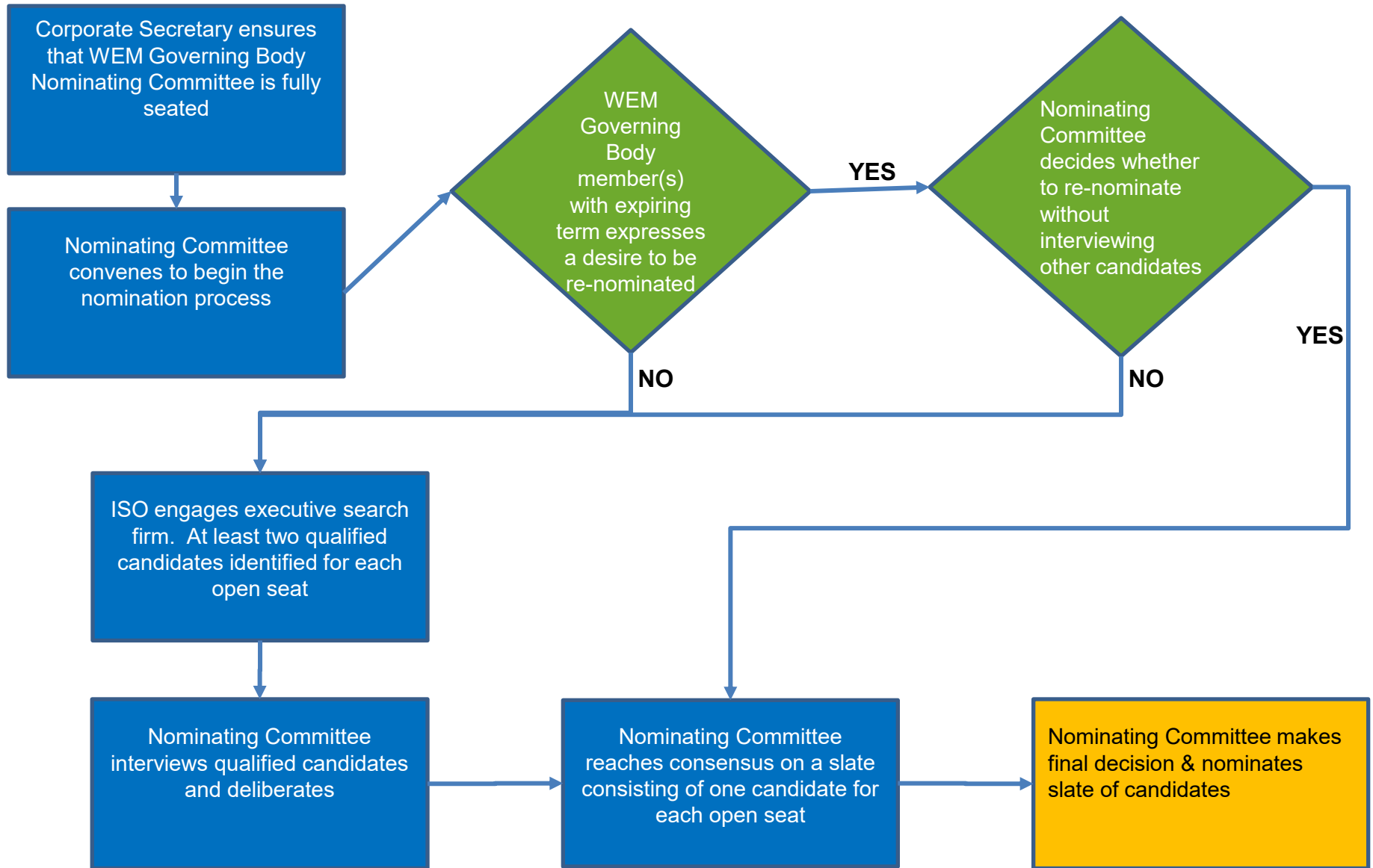
- Term for WEM Governing Body member Anita Decker will end effective June 30, 2026.
- WEM Governing Body members are nominated by a WEM Governing Body Nominating Committee of stakeholder representatives and appointed by the WEM Governing Body.
- The Governing Body Nominating Committee began its process in January 2026.
- Member Decker has expressed a desire to be nominated for a new term, beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2029.
- Nominating Committee considered the potential re-nomination of Member Decker versus potential search for a new candidate.

Process for member selection and approval



Selection and approval process

The Nominating Committee met on multiple occasions and undertook the following actions:

- Conducted a collective assessment of the needs of the WEM
- Reviewed the qualifications and accomplishments of Member Decker
- Interviewed Member Decker
- Solicited and considered sector feedback on Member and needs of the WEM

At the conclusion of the selection process, the WEM Nominating Committee reached a consensus determination to re-nominate Member Decker for another term.

WEM Nominating Committee Nomination

The Nominating Committee recommends that the WEM Governing Body reappoint Anita Decker, for a term beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2029.
