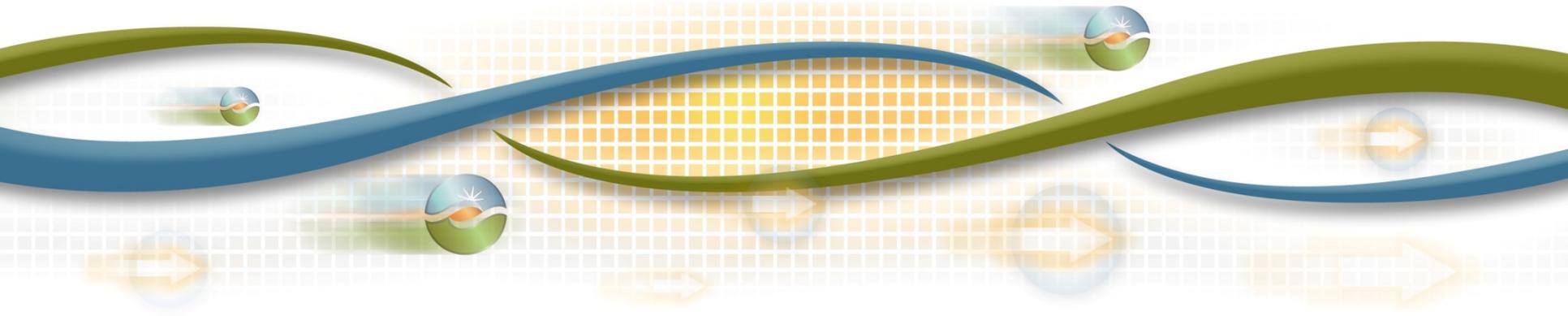




Decision on tariff amendment regarding conceptual statewide plan

Since 2010, the ISO has prepared and published the statewide plan as part of its annual planning process.

- Development of the statewide plan facilitated coordination with the California Transmission Planning Group (CTPG)
- Implementation of FERC Order No. 1000 has supplanted the need to develop the statewide plan
 - CTPG is no longer functioning and its members are focused on regional planning through Order 1000
 - The statewide plan no longer facilitates the coordination function it was intended to provide
- ISO developing the plan on its own diverts resources away from Order 1000 activities

Management recommends the Board approve the proposal to remove the requirement of developing a conceptual statewide plan from the tariff.

- No stakeholder objected to this proposal
 - May 18, 2017 - Draft straw proposal to remove the requirement was shared with stakeholders
 - Stakeholder call held on May 25, 2017
 - Minor comments were received and addressed by the ISO
 - June 22, 2017 - A final draft final proposal was posted
 - No further stakeholder comments were received
- Implementation of FERC Order No. 1000 has supplanted the need to develop the conceptual statewide plan
