SunZia Transmission, LLC

Issued: February 21, 2025

On October 21, 2024, SunZia Transmission, LLC (SunZia) filed an executed, non-conforming Large Generator Interconnection Agreement (LGIA) among SunZia, SunZia Wind South LLC, and the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO), under SunZia's Transmission Owner Tariff.¹ Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, the LGIA is accepted for filing, effective December 31, 9998, as requested.²

The filing was publicly noticed. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 385.214), notices of intervention, timely-filed motions to intervene, and any unopposed motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed document(s); nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against SunZia.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the

² SunZia requests that the LGIA become effective on the date on which operational control of the SunZia Transmission System is granted to CAISO. SunZia must notify the Commission of the actual effective date within five business days of that date in an eTariff submittal using Type of Filing Code 150 – Report.

Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
