**Notice of Cancellation of EIM Implementation Agreement with the City of  
Seattle, by and through its City Light Department**

Dear Secretary Reese:

The California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submits for Commission acceptance this notice of cancellation of the Energy Imbalance Market Implementation Agreement between the CAISO and the City of Seattle, by and through its City Light Department (SCL) (Implementation Agreement).<sup>1</sup> The CAISO is cancelling the Implementation Agreement in accordance with its terms, because the tariff revisions and service agreements needed to implement SCL participation in the Western Energy Imbalance Market have gone into effect.

The CAISO requests that the Commission accept this notice of cancellation effective 61 days after the date of this filing, *i.e.*, April 29, 2026.

**I. Background and Basis for Cancellation**

In 2017, the Commission accepted for filing the CAISO's submittal of the Implementation Agreement and granted the CAISO's requested effective date of April 1, 2017.<sup>2</sup>

Section 1(c) of the Implementation Agreement states that the agreement shall terminate upon the earliest of any of several specified events that include "the date all necessary revisions to the SCL Tariff to take effect and the date FERC permits all

necessary revisions to the ISO tariff necessary for the commencement of SCL's participation in the EIM have taken effect." The events described in the quoted provision of the Implementation Agreement have occurred.<sup>3</sup>

For these reasons, the Implementation Agreement is no longer needed and has terminated. Therefore, the CAISO requests that the Commission accept this notice of cancellation effective 61 days after the date of this filing, *i.e.*, April 29, 2026.
