On January 7, 2025, the California Independent System Operator Corporation submitted a certificate of concurrence and tariff record¹ to the Large Generator Interconnection Agreement between Southern California Edison Company and Coso Energy Developers, Coso Power Developers, Coso Battery Storage, LLC, and Mordor ES2 LLC.² Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, the submittal is accepted for filing, effective November 15, 2024, as requested.³

The filing was publicly noticed. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission’s regulations (18 C.F.R. § 385.214), notices of intervention, timely-filed motions to intervene, and any unopposed motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted.
