Reference: Tariff Revisions

On November 22, 2019, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed a tariff amendment to allow for the sharing of confidential data with certain federal agencies in the event of a cyberattack on CAISO systems. To allow for this data sharing, CAISO proposes a new provision specific to the sharing of confidential information with federal agencies who have cybersecurity responsibilities, without notice to affected market participants, in the event of a “Cyber Exigency” and a new definition for the term “Cyber Exigency.” The tariff revisions are accepted for filing, effective February 5, 2020, as requested.¹

This filing was noticed on November 22, 2019, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before December 13, 2019. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed

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contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
