**PETITION OF THE CALIFORNIA INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPERATOR TO
FURTHER EXTEND THE DEADLINE FOR
FILING FORM 3-Q FOR THE THIRD QUARTER OF 2008**

The California Independent System Operator Corporation, or "ISO," submits this petition (see 18 C.F.R. § 207) to request a further extension of time to file the Form 3-Q for the third quarter of 2008 due to technical issues.

Without an extension, the ISO's Form 3-Q form would be due today. The ISO's deadline was extended to January 9, 2009 by the Chief Accountant in an order issued November 25, 2008. On January 9, the ISO filed a petition requesting an additional extension of two weeks, until January 23, 2009.

In the meantime, the ISO has completed its Form 3-Q, and has been attempting to file its submission for the past two days. The filing is not complete due to technical problems with the software (FOSS), which FERC online support has referred to the software developer.

The ISO requests an extension of one additional week to allow time resolve this technical problem. With this extension, the form would be due January 30, 2009.
