MOTION FOR PARTY STATUS OF THE CALIFORNIA INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPERATOR CORPORATION

Pursuant to Commission Rules of Practice and Procedure 1.4(a)(4) and 11.1, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) hereby moves for leave to become a party to this proceeding.

The CAISO is a California not for profit public benefit corporation charged with reliably planning and operating the high voltage transmission system for its participating transmission owners, including Pacific Gas & Electric Company (PG&E). The CAISO is an active participant in many Commission proceedings, including applications for Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) required to construct CAISO-approved transmission projects.

In this proceeding, PG&E filed an application for a CPCN to authorize construction of the Northern San Joaquin 230 kV Transmission Project, a new double-circuit 230 kV transmission line from Lockeford Substation to a new Thurman Switching Station in Lodi and looping the existing Brighton-Bellota 230 kV line through Lockeford Substation. The CAISO identified this project in its 2017-2018 Transmission Plan to address reliability concerns, including thermal overloads and voltage issues under North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) Category P1 and P6 contingencies.¹ The project will enhance system reliability by increasing capacity to serve growing loads in the Northern San Joaquin area, mitigating the risk of widespread outages due to single-source dependency, and ensuring compliance with applicable reliability standards.
