On May 23, 2022, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed revisions to its Open Access Transmission Tariff (Tariff)¹ in compliance with the directives in an April 22, 2022 Commission order.² Specifically, CAISO has revised the Tariff language to remove a 20% adder and replace it with CAISO's alternative proposal for pricing capacity procurement mechanism offers above the soft-offer cap. The revisions are in satisfactory compliance with the April 22 Order. Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307 (2021), the revisions are accepted for filing, effective April 22, 2022, as requested.

The filing was publicly noticed, with interventions and protests due on or before June 13, 2021. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2021)), notices of intervention, timely-filed motions to intervene, and any unopposed motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted. No protests or adverse comments were filed.
