**MOTION FOR PARTY STATUS OF THE CALIFORNIA INDEPENDENT  
SYSTEM OPERATOR CORPORATION**

Pursuant to Commission Rules of Practice and Procedure 1.4(a)(4) and 11.1, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) hereby moves for leave to become a party to this proceeding.

The CAISO is a California not for profit public benefit corporation charged with reliably planning and operating the high voltage transmission system for its participating transmission owners, including Pacific Gas & Electric Company (PG&E). The CAISO is an active participant in many Commission proceedings, including applications for permits to construct CAISO-approved transmission projects.

In this proceeding, Horizon West Transmission, LLC (formally known as NextEra Energy Transmission West, LLC (NEET West)) and PG&E jointly filed an application for permits to construct the Estrella Substation and Paso Robles Area Reinforcement Project (Proposed Project). The California Independent System Operator Corporation identified the Proposed Project as a necessary solution to meet reliability-driven transmission system needs in its 2013-2014 Transmission Plan. Because the CAISO identified the reliability need for the Proposed Project, the CAISO is uniquely situated to address project benefits and assess potential alternatives. The CAISO intends to present legal and factual contentions regarding the purpose of the Proposed Project and project benefits.
