Dear Mr. Anders:

On April 27, 2012, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted a Dynamic Transfer Balancing Authority Operating Agreement with the Balancing Authority of Northern California (BANC) (Service Agreement No. 2502). Concurrently, CAISO submitted a Notice of Termination of the Balancing Authority Area Pilot Pseudo-Tie Continuation Agreement with BANC (Service Agreement No. 1965). Service Agreement No. 2502 and the Notice of Termination of Service Agreement No. 1965 are accepted, effective June 28, 2012.

This filing was noticed on April 27, 2012, with comments, protests or motions to intervene due on or before May 18, 2012. None were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 211 and Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R § 385.211 and § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding

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now pending or hereafter instituted by or against your company.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
