III. CAISO’S INTEREST

Palomar Energy Center (“Facility”) is located within SDG&E’s transmission system and is needed to maintain the reliability of the ISO Controlled Grid. Both facilities are needed to maintain the reliability of the ISO Controlled Grid. As the Control Area operator and as the counter party to the RMR Agreements, the CAISO has a unique interest in any Commission proceeding that affects an RMR Agreement. Accordingly, the CAISO has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding and requests that it be permitted to intervene. Because no other party can adequately represent the CAISO’s interests in this proceeding, the CAISO’s intervention is in the public interest and should be granted.

IV. MOTION TO INTERVENE OUT OF TIME

Due to an administrative oversight, the ISO failed to file this motion by the date specified in the June 14, 2006, Notice of Filing. Given the early status of the proceeding, however, no party will be prejudiced by the granting of the motion.

V. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, the CAISO respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Motion to Intervene and make the CAISO a party in the above-caption proceeding with full rights of participation.
